Greetings Neighbors!

Winter is finally gone, the total eclipse has passed and Spring is now upon us! As we move into the warmer days of Spring, it's time to get busy and clean up the debris and residual mess that Winter left in our yards. Maintaining an attractive community while protecting our property values is the primary goal of the Meadows Property Owners Association (MPOA). Per the MPOA Restrictions, our Board of Directors is responsible for governing the general aesthetics of our neighborhood. However, we cannot achieve success without the assistance of every neighbor who likewise needs to maintain their own property.

To this end, we make the following three simple requests of you at this time.

- Mailboxes Please walk out and take a good look at your mailbox. It's the first object that everyone sees when they approach your house. Does it need paint? Is it old and cracking? Let's bring it in line with the norms and governing rules of the MPOA. If you need to replace your mailbox, please see the attached sheet with information on new mailboxes that meet the requirements of the MPOA Restrictions. Note that plastic mailboxes and bare metal mailboxes are not allowed.
- 2. Yard and House While you're outside, stand at the curb and admire your yard and house. These, just like your mailbox, are on display for everyone. Do you have a yard in need of weed control or edging? Shrub beds with weeds? Trees that need trimming or perhaps dead trees in need of removal? Is your house ready for paint or some new window blinds?
- 3. Garbage Cans Do you find garbage cans or trash bags on display? Just like your mailbox, garbage receptacle storage is governed by our Restrictions which state that all garbage bags, cans and bins must be stored <u>inside</u> the garage or house, not outside of the house. The Restrictions, along with the Bylaws, can be found on the MPOA website.

The Meadows is a very pleasant neighborhood that we can all be proud of. So, this Spring, we are asking every property owner to make the appropriate repairs and replacements needed to keep your property looking nice and in compliance with our Restrictions.

This review will be performed by an independent financial person who does not live in The Meadows, as required per the Bylaws.
- <u>Annual Meeting</u> This meeting of all Meadows property owners will be held on Tuesday, September 17 at 7:00pm at Te'kela's restaurant. There will be several important issues to discuss at this meeting so please mark your calendars now to attend!
- <u>Block Party</u> Our 2nd Annual Block Party will be held Sunday, October 6. Time and exact location TBD. Enjoy music, food vendors, and entertainment for the kids such as a bounce house, facepainting and mini-golf. Join your neighbors for an afternoon of fun and relaxation!
- <u>Home or Property Renovations/Additions</u> Be sure to advise the Board when you are planning to make changes to your home and/or property as all exterior renovations/additions must be approved by the Board <u>prior</u> to starting work on your project.
